Step 1

Unregister with the State:

**If you have an LLC S-Corp, you
must first Revoke your S-Corp**

Step 2

Once you have Revoked the S-Corp or if you have no S-Corp

Dissolve the Corporate Entity

Unregister, and tell the SOS that you are Dissolving the Corporation.

Most of this can be done online in Colorado.

Step 3

If you are keeping the same Business Name:

Reconvey the Business to the Land & Soil Jurisdiction

Record a Certificate of Assumed Name with Your Business Name declared in it

If you are Creating a New Business:

Create it as a Private Family Business

Record a Certificate of Assumed Name with Your Business Name declared in it.
